

Truckee High School Parking Permit Application

The parking permit is good for the current school year. Seniors have priority on receiving a parking permit. All applications are processed digitally

Only students with current paperwork, including driver's license, proof of insurance uploaded to the google form, parent signature on *this* form, and email confirmation from an administrator, will be issued parking permits.

PARKING/DRIVING REGULATIONS:

I understand that the operation of student vehicles on school grounds is a privilege. I agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:

- All students must be licensed, insured and have parental permission to receive a parking permit and drive to school.
- The school has the right to regulate driving privileges.
- If an attendance (tardiness or truancy) or discipline problems develop, the parking permit and the student's driving privilege may be suspended and/or revoked without prior warning.
- The Truckee High Parking Permit must be visible. Every student vehicle parked on THS main campus grounds must have a parking permit.
- Parking is strictly limited to the student parking areas. Students must park in their designated painted parking stall. The following areas are off limits to parking: dirt, grass, rocks, snow banks, diagonally painted areas or any other inappropriate areas.
- The student driver is responsible for the vehicle or its contents; the student assumes full responsibility for the vehicle while it is on the lot. Any vehicle parked on school premises is subject to search in accordance with the TTUSD search and seizure policy.
- Keep vehicles locked at all times. TTUSD and Truckee High School cannot accept responsibility for vehicle damage, lost, or stolen items.
- Any student must surrender his/her parking permit when requested by the Truckee High School Administration.
- Speed limit on school property is 5 mph. Speeding, reckless driving, or "showing off" will be cause for suspended or revoked parking privileges.
- Students may not receive a parking permit until all fines and other financial obligations are paid.
- No congregating in or around cars during the school day (including lunch)
- Cars are not lockers and cannot be accessed during the school day without permission.
- Parking spots are not able to be monitored or reserved for students without a first or second period.
- I understand that failure to follow the above mentioned rules and regulations will result in the loss of my driving privilege on this campus as follows:
1st offense - warning and/or 5 days, 2nd offense – up to 30 days, 3rd offense - remainder of semester and/or school year. Behavior infractions may result in loss of parking privileges.
 - PARKING REGULATIONS ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED. IT IS A PRIVILEGE TO DRIVE TO AND PARK ON SCHOOL GROUNDS, SUSPENSION/REVOKING OF PARKING PRIVILEGES, TOWING AT OWNER'S EXPENSE, SUSPENSION FROM SCHOOL AND/OR OTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION MAY RESULT WHEN VIOLATIONS OF PARKING REGULATIONS OCCUR
