

Measure A is a low-cost, flat parcel tax that generates funding for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD). Thanks to Measure A our students at Alder Creek Middle School have access to an array of opportunities that have ceased to exist in many public middle schools.

Based on their enrollment of 491 students, Alder Creek Middle School received a total of \$569,444 for the 2014-15 school year. The following programs are partially or fully funded through the Measure A parcel tax.

- Band, Music classes, equipment, supplies, and instruments
- Science activities, lab supplies, and fieldwork
- Technology upgrades, maintenance and classes
- Computers
- Counselors
- Physical Education classes and supplies
- Spanish classes
- Library books
- Classroom supplies and equipment

Funding from Measure A has also been used at Alder Creek Middle School for Art, Drama, Quest, and Odyssey of the Mind. Activities conducted by the Measure A funded counselor include Let's Get Real Anti Bullying Curriculum for 6th grade, Tobacco & Alcohol Education 7th grade, Alcohol & Drug Education 8th grade, Sexual Harassment Prevention through Tahoe Safe Alliance, Red Ribbon Week, Mix It Up Day, No Name Calling Week, Career Cruising 8th grade, Ten Talk-Sex Education 8th grade, Transitions for incoming 6th graders and outgoing 8th graders, Homeroom Day-Guidance curriculum, Sources of Strength for 28 students as Peer Helpers & Safe School Ambassadors, Assemblies, Movie Night, & Ski Duck (10 trips).
