

Measure A is a low-cost, flat parcel tax that generates funding for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD). Thanks to Measure A our students at North Tahoe School have access to an array of opportunities that have ceased to exist in most public elementary and middle schools.

Based on their enrollment of 406 students, North Tahoe School received a total of \$457,036 for the 2014-15 school year. The following programs are partially or fully funded through the Measure A parcel tax.

Fifth-grade

- Technology upgrades, maintenance and classes
- Science activities, supplies, and fieldwork
- Library books
- Physical Education classes and supplies
- Counselors and Special Friends program
- Classroom supplies and equipment

Sixth - Eighth-Grade

- Band, Music classes, equipment and supplies
- Science activities, labs, supplies, and fieldwork
- Technology upgrades, maintenance and classes
- Counselors
- Physical Education supplies
- Library books
- Classroom supplies and equipment

- School Nurse
- Bus Replacement
