



Measure A is a low-cost, flat parcel tax that generates funding for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD). **Thanks to Measure A our students at North Tahoe High School have access to an array of opportunities that have ceased to exist in most public high schools.**

Based on their enrollment of 362 students, North Tahoe High School received a total of \$421,164 for the 2015-16 school year. The following programs are partially or fully funded through the Measure A parcel tax.

- Advanced Placement classes
- Career Tech classes and materials
- Band, equipment and supplies
- Science activities and lab supplies
- Technology upgrades and maintenance
- Naviance - college and career online planning program
- Librarian and library books
- SAT Prep workshop
- Art materials
