

Measure A is a low-cost, flat parcel tax that generates funding for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD). Thanks to Measure A our students at North Tahoe School have access to an array of opportunities that have ceased to exist in most public elementary and middle schools.

North Tahoe School received a total of \$487,369 for the 2015-16 school year. The following programs are partially or fully funded through the Measure A parcel tax.
