Measure A is a low-cost, flat parcel tax that generates funding for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD). **Thanks to Measure A our students at North Tahoe High School have access to an array of opportunities that have ceased to exist in most public high schools.**

Based on their enrollment of 398 students, North Tahoe High School received a total of \$485,870 for the 2016 - 2017 school year. The following programs are partially or fully funded through the Measure A parcel tax.

- Advanced Placement classes and prep exams
- Career Tech classes and materials
- Band, equipment and supplies
- Science activities and lab supplies
- Technology upgrades and maintenance
- Naviance - college and career online planning program
- Librarian and library books
- Art classes and materials
- Physical Education supplies
- Classroom supplies and equipment
