



Measure A is a low-cost, flat parcel tax that generates funding for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD). **Thanks to Measure A our students at North Tahoe School have access to an array of opportunities that have ceased to exist in most public elementary and middle schools.**

Based on their enrollment of 445 students, North Tahoe School received a total of \$518,538 for the 2016 – 2017 school year. The following programs are partially or fully funded through the Measure A parcel tax.

**Fifth-grade**
