- The meeting began with a welcome from Superintendent Chief Learning Officer Rob Leri, and introductions around the table.
- TTUSD's meeting norms were reviewed. No other norms were added.
- Superintendent Chief Learning Officer Rob Leri gave a brief overview of the role of the committee. Dr. Leri's predecessor formed the group initially as a way to directly share info between parents and the CLO and for committee members to serve as liaisons between the school and the district. A few years ago, under Dr. Leri, the responsibilities of the committee expanded to also serve as the Parent Advisory for the LCAP as well.
- Dr. Leri shared the theme for this school year - Living in the Learning Zone and what it means to us. He referenced a video that will be shared with the group in an email. People live in two zones - one that is more routinized based, if you're always in your zone, you don't stretch yourself, challenge yourself, make mistakes and grow. We want parents and teachers to learn new things, try new things, and make mistakes and we want to be part of this cycle. We want kids to be in this cycle. Be willing to take a risk and share. Rob shared a CLO example of his living in the learning zone and the delayed opening of Kings Beach Elementary.
- Dr. Leri shared district updates as well as updates on the facility upgrade projects.
- Dr. Leri reminded/informed the parents that the renewal measure, Measure AA, is on the November ballot.
- PTO Leadership Summit will be held on November 8, 2018, at 8:30 a.m. at the District Office and is in place of the Parent Advisory meeting for November. All committee members are invited and encouraged to attend.
