Twomey shared the district updates including updates from last night's board meeting.

Valerie Simpson gave an update on LCAP and while her handouts included Goal 1, Goal 2 and Goal 3, she focused specifically on Goal 2. (The previous meeting Simpson covered Goal 1 which has to do with student learning.) Goal 2 is "ensuring all staff members are implementing effective instructional strategies, providing quality learning opportunities, integrating technology, and utilizing data to actively engage each scholar to learn at the highest levels, gain 21<sup>st</sup> century skills in order to be prepared for college, career, and life. (TTUSD Pathways 2020 Goals 1 & 2) Goal 3 is about a safe, supportive, collaborative environment.

Kelli Twomey shared a quick update on the work of the Later School Start Committee.

Kelli Twomey announced the district's new digital flyer program (Peachjar).
